



## Show & General Rules

1. All NRHA Memberships & Horse registrations & Licences MUST be sent with nominations to showsecretary.csrhc@gmail.com. Failure to do so may result in a \$50 fine.

2. NRHA rules apply to all NRHA classes & CSRHC classes except where otherwise indicated. NRHA stewardship still applies to ALL horses competing in the show.

3. CSRHC classes – Rider must be a full or event member of CSRHC to compete in CSRHC classes.

4. NRHA Classes – Both owners and riders must be current NRHA members to compete in NRHA classes. Horses must have a valid NRHA competition licence to compete in NRHA classes. NRHA OC eligibilities apply.

5. NRHA Green Reiner- NRHA Association membership is required, no NRHA licence in required for the horse. Riders may use a horse without the restrictions of ownership defined in Non Pro Conditions. Owner must have Associate NRHA Membership at minimum.

6. Non Pros must hold a non-pro card or complete a Non Pro Declaration form with their entry. NRHA Non Pro horse ownership rules apply unless otherwise stipulated.

7. 4 yo Futurity is for horses 4 yo as at January 1<sup>st</sup> 2024. Horse is be ridden 1 handed in a bridle. Riders may enter any class they are eligible for as per NRHA Eligibility.

8. Derby is for horses aged 5,6,7,8 as at January 1<sup>st</sup> 2024. Horse to be ridden 1 handed in a bridle. Riders may enter any class they are eligible for as per NRHA Eligibility. Youth riders must enter at least one other class other than Youth Derby.

9. Barry Delbridge Memorial ride is open to all riders with an NRHA Membership OR CSRHC Membership. Any rider eligible to enter Green Reiner or Rookies will receive +1/2 point. Horses may be ridden 1 or 2 handed and may change throughout class without penalty.

9. All NRHA sanctioned classes are qualifiers for the OC Championship Show 2024.

10. Photocopies or attached file of competition licence, registration, and membership cards must accompany entries.

11. Competitors entering concurrent classes will pay only 1 judges fee.

12. Bank details must be provided for all Payouts.

# Penalties, Fines & Refunds

1. Stables & Camping must be reserved through Nominate and booked 48 business hours prior to arrival to avoid a Late Fee. The show will be in the Covered Arena at Maryborough Showgrounds & Equestrian Park. Stable blocks A-H are closest. DO NOT PAY FACILITY FEE WITH YOUR STABLING & CAMPING. FACILITY FEE WILL BE COLLECTED WITH YOUR NOMINATIONS.

2. Scratches accompanied by a vet certificate and received prior to the first day of the show will receive their stabling & nominations back less office & facility fees.

3. Any competitor that enters in a class for which they are ineligible will incur a \$50 fine. NRHA Eligibilities can be checked on NRHA Reiner Suite. If in doubt contact the Show Secretary.

#### Payouts

- 1. NRHA payback percentages will be used to calculate payouts unless otherwise stipulated.
- 2. CSRHC will retain 50% of entry fees except for Derby & 4yo Futurity which will have 100% added back.
- 3. Payouts will be paid via eft within 30 days of the show after confirmation of results is received from NRHA.

## **Eligibility**

1. It is the competitors responsibility to be aware of their earnings and enter classes accordingly. Eligibility criteria are explained in the class list provided in the Show Package for all classes and are as of Jan 1st 2024.

2. NRHA classes use NRHA earnings only, which are monies earned in an NRHA approved event. NRHA OCEANIA Eligibility lists are available at www.nrha.com Reiners Suite.

3. Horse Age is taken as horses age as at 1st January 2024. Derby horses are 5,6,7,8 year olds.

**Entries** 

1. Entries to be made via www.scrha.com.au and must be accompanied by payment.

2. Late entries for previously nominated horses will be taken up to 4pm the day before the class. At that point entry for the next day will be closed. No exceptions. Late entry fee of \$25 per class. Horses will run last.

3. Draws will be posted 10pm for next day classes. Draws may differ from the program if late entries are received. Please check the draws posted for late entries & scratchings.

4. An indemnity & liability form must be completed by all competitors.

5. Horse Health Declaration must be completed & submitted at the show office.

#### Arena Availability

1. See show package for specific Open Pen Times, Bump in & Office Hours.

2. Show management reserves the right to close the pen for arena maintenance at any time they deem necessary.

3. Every horse on the grounds (stabled or day only ) will be charged a Facility Fee.

4. Open pen rules apply. Circles at top half of hour. Left at the gate, right at far end. Stops at bottom half of the hour. No stopping in the centre. Be aware of horses around you before backing or schooling.

5. At the entry of the tractor to the arena at any time ALL horses must move to the side of the pen and remain stationary or leave the pen while the drag is taking place.

6. No Lunging in the show pen or in the warm up area near the covered arena.

7. Every horse being ridden in the arena must have a back number on at all times. Horses not included in entries must obtain a back number and pay Facility Fees at the show office.

8. Maryborough Showground & Equestrian Park Rules & Conditions must be followed at all times.

### Show Management

1. Any concerns must be directed to the NRHA Show Manager - and Show Representative - Ed Smith's attention as soon as possible

2. No mistreatment or abuse of a horse will be tolerated. No over schooling of horses will be tolerated.

3. NRHA & CSRHC maintains a drug free policy.

4. All competitors and spectators must conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner at all times.

5. Show management decisions will be final and binding.

6. All horses being ridden must be in full tack while on the grounds. Riding double or bareback is not allowed.

7. Any incidents or injuries to be reported immediately. Safety Officer on ground is Paul Sharp.

#### Paid Times

1. Paid Warm Ups are on a first pay first serve basis. Limit 2 slots (either together or split) per horse. Paid Times are for horses competing only and are to be booked and paid for at the show office. Paid times will be in 2 hour blocks followed by 2 hour Open Pen.
